Anyone with an interest in art and/or faith is very welcome.

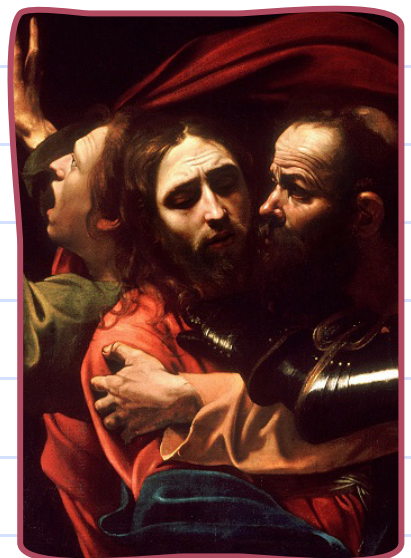
The weekend is led by Deborah Lewer, Senior Lecturer in History of Art at the University of Glasgow.
